Bohnak offered the following resolution: A resolution to declare October 16, 2025, as Community Dispute 1 Resolution Day in the state of Michigan. 2 3 Whereas, Alternative dispute resolution covers mediation, 4 arbitration, facilitation, restorative practices, collaborative decision-making, and other effective ways to address conflict; and 5 Whereas, The conflict resolution process enables individuals, 6 7 families, communities, organizations, and businesses to enhance communication and develop solutions that address the needs and 8 9 interests of all parties involved; and 10 Whereas Conflict resolution is taught and practiced by individuals across Michigan and around the world in schools, 11 12 community colleges, universities, law schools, and graduate 13 programs, both as a method for resolving disputes and as a pathway 14 to fostering a more peaceful society; and
